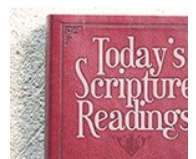

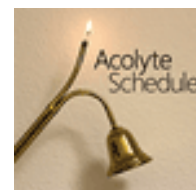

Sacrarium

The Sacrarium is also known as The Sacristy Sink. This is a special sink that drains directly into the ground. In our church it is in one of the rooms behind the altar. This sink is to be used to wash out the sacred vessels and altar linens. This is done to prevent any small particle of the host or consecrated wine from becoming lost or unintentionally profaned. All visible Host particles and Precious Blood is to be consumed. At no time should the Consecrated Hosts or the Precious Blood be emptied into this sink.

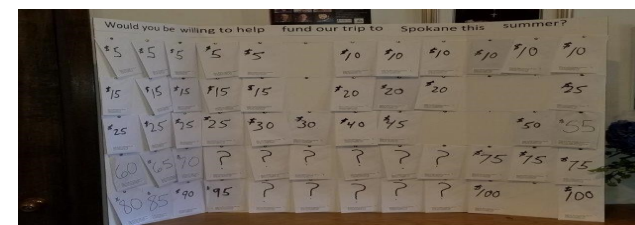


Free Little Pantry
